Around the Region

Western Wyoming Community College

The Western Wyoming Mustangs are off to a 7-2 start, including winning four straight games. The team, last week, dropped Rocky Mountain J.V. as Kaydee Williams had 15 points. They then beat Little Big Horn College as Lindee McKinley had 19 points. The team also beat Western Montana J.V. in two games two weeks ago. In the first game, Lacy Larsen paced the team with a double-double, collecting 12 points and 10 rebounds. In the second contest, Sami Cornelison finished with 16 points and pulled down eight rebounds.

Northeast Community College

The Northeast Hawks are led by a variety of players, but it is Jasmine Lovejoy that is taking the leadership role after leading her team in scoring in six of the 10 games played so far this year. Lovejoy started things with a 19-point effort in the first game of the season against North Dakota Science. She then led the team in scoring in the last four games, scoring 17 against Southeastern Iowa and North Dakota Science, and then had 16 points against Mount Marty J.V. and then had 15 points against Northeastern Colorado in a loss.

Casper College

The Casper Thunderbirds are 10-3 on the season and have had a balanced scoring and offensive output. In a contest against Yakima Valley, Emily Elliott had a triple-double, finishing with 21 points, 12 rebounds and 12 assists. Elliott also led the team with 18 points in a loss to Otero. Samira Van Grinsven also had a good week, getting a double-double in a win against Idaho All-stars with 15 points and 10 rebounds. Josie Stewart also had a pair of double-doubles, getting 17 points and 12 rebounds against McCook, and then had 16 points and 10 rebounds against Yakima Valley.

Western Nebraska Community College

The WNCC Cougars are 7-3 on the season and have been led by freshman Stormye Everett as the leading scorer in the last four games. Everett had 15 points in a win against Northern Oklahoma-Tonkawa and a loss to Barton County. She also had 18 points in a win against Central Wyoming, and poured in 23 points against the Torrington all-stars. Last weekend, the Cougars split a pair of games, losing a tough contest to Williston State 70-68, missing a shot at the buzzer to tie it. Tawny Drexler led with 20 points. They rebounded

with a win against the Nebraska All-stars as Shquilah Davis finished with 16 points.

North Platte Community College

Roshonda Gayden showed why she could be one of the top players in Division II this year as the sophomore had three 20-plus point performances, including 27 points and 11 rebounds against Ottawa J.V., 26 points and 13 rebounds against Iowa Lakes Community College, and 23 points against Barton County. She also had a double-double of 17 points and 14 rebounds against Des Moines

Northeastern Junior College

The NJC Plainswomen picked up two wins by dropping Northeast Nebraska and Southeast Nebraska last week. Against Southeast, Sabelle Diata had a double-double with 11 points and 13 rebounds. Kristy Henderson paced the team with 13 points and she also had seven steals. Henderson also poured in 19 points in a win against the Hawks, while Sabelle Diata finished with 15 points.

Sheridan College

The Sheridan Generals are 10-1 on the season and are led by sophomore Tahnee Robinson, who is averaging 31 points a game.
