Camp Director Mike Jones

Mike Jones just finished his eighth year at the helm of the Cougar baseball team and each and every year, Jones' teams make a run at the regional championship. This past season, the Cougars finished second in the Empire Conference and made the 4-team regional playoffs. Two seasons ago, the team recorded it's first Region IX championship by defeating Trinidad State twice for the title, and Jones also earned Region IX Coach of the Year honors.



The Cougars, however, have always been in the hunt for a regional title or top three placing. In 2004, the team took second at the regional championships. In 2005, the Cougars finished third and in 2006, the team finished fourth.

Jones has made the Cougars a Region IX power after taking command of the baseball team in 2001-02. Jones is the only baseball coach WNCC has had. In his eight years at WNCC, he has a 197-201 record. Jones is in his 10th year overall as a junior college coach, spending the previous three years at Dodge City Community College. At Dodge City, he had a 94-71 record. His overall junior college record stands at 291-272. He also served as an assistant baseball coach at Dodge City from 1995-96.

As a native of Overland Park, Kan., Jones began his playing career at Avila College in Kansas City. Following two seasons at Avila, he transferred to Emporia State University where he helped lead the team to its first MIAA championship as a starting pitcher in 1993. His coaching career started in 1994 at Emporia State as an assistant coach.

Jones has been active with the American Legion in both Dodge City and Gering. He was a member of the 1993 MIAA championship team at Emporia State and participated in the NCAA Division II national tournament.
