AA.1313A (67-68 Credits)

This emphasis area offers the first two years of basic music requirements for the baccalaureate degree in Music Education. The non-music courses that are suggested will meet the College's requirements for the Associate of Arts degree.

Objectives

- Provide the music requirements in Music Theory and Ear Training.
- Provide music requirements in applied music major area and keyboard.
- Provide ensemble participation.
- Provide related education courses.
- Provide options in related areas of study.
- Provide options for music minor participation.

Notes

- Students who plan to transfer to a four-year college/university should consult their faculty advisor and the Transfer Advisor early in their WNCC enrollment to determine their curriculum.
- EDUC-2860 is strongly suggested for Elementary Education students of sophomore standing or higher. It is not recommended for first semester students.
- MUSC-2370 and MUSC-2390 may not be offered every year. Students should check with their advisors.
