

NURSING/PRE-PROFESSIONAL

AS.5116B (67 Credits)

This emphasis area provides students with the basic courses for entry into two, three and four-year professional nursing programs. The courses are applicable to various other related programs.

Objectives

- Provide students with a detailed understanding of the structure and function of the human body.
- Provide students with basic chemical principles applicable to the human body.
- Provide students with an appreciation for those environmental phenomena that affect the human body.
- Provide students with an opportunity to learn the principles by which humans interact with others.

Notes

- Students who plan to transfer to a four-year college/university should consult their faculty advisor and the Transfer Advisor early in their WNCC enrollment to determine their curriculum.
- This emphasis area is designed in cooperation with the [University of Nebraska Medical Center College Of Nursing](#). Students should work closely with a transfer advisor or their faculty advisor to ensure transfer requirements are met.
- Application for admission to the UNMC College of Nursing or another nursing program the student desires to attend must be made directly to that program in addition to application to WNCC.
- UNMC College of Nursing will give priority admissions consideration to students applying prior to December 31st.
- Suggested electives: CHEM-1640, INFO-1100, and FACS-1540.
