### **Programs and Awards:**

#### **CC.5199 (24 Credits)**

This program is designed to prepare ambulance personnel in handling medical emergencies.

Included is training in response to burns, cardiovascular emergencies, infections, diseases, obstetric emergencies, drug administration, and other types of medical emergencies.

### **Objectives**

- Provide the ability to respond to medical emergencies such as heart attacks, injuries, and childbirth.
- Provide the concepts required to administer medications, life support, and other emergency responses.
- Provide the special abilities to work with newborn infants, the elderly, the mentally ill, and trauma victims.

### **Notes**

- Students must demonstrate competency in writing and mathematics by assessment (ASSET) or by passing the appropriate mathematics and writing courses (MATH-0150, MATH-0160, or OFFT-1500 **and** ACFS-0050W). This is in addition to the required curriculum for this program.
- Prior to registering for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester, the student must provide verification of being a current EMT-Basic to the program coordinator who will then register the student for the course.
- Students will take the didactic portions of the course at the Scottsbluff campus. Students can make arrangements with the program coordinator to do a portion of their field experience in their home communities.
