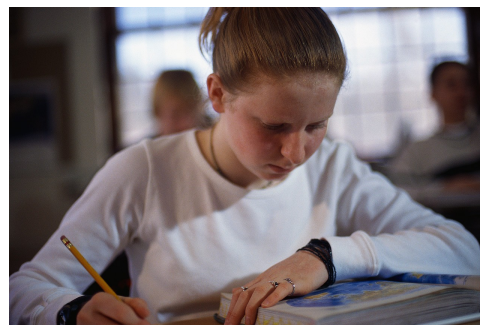


INDEPENDENT STUDY COURSES

Independent Study Courses are open entry/open exit and are available to all students. They offer an alternative to students to enter credit courses at times other than the beginning of the three college terms. Some courses are developmental in nature to assist students with improving basic skills. Other courses are offered as electives to enhance study in an Associate Degree program.

Courses offered are:

- ✓ Basic Math (4 credits)
- ✓ Business Math (3 credits)
- ✓ Spelling Improvement (2 credits)
- ✓ Vocabulary Improvement (2 credits)
- ✓ College Vocabulary (2 credits)
- ✓ Rapid Reading (2 credits)
- ✓ Spanish for the Traveler (2 credits)



• ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES

Students must complete an enrollment form in Student Services and bring a copy of the registration to the ILAC to verify enrollment. Tuition and fees are charged per credit hour of enrollment and are paid in the Business Office.

• CLASS MATERIALS

Upon verification of enrollment, the student will receive an instruction sheet on ILAC procedures and a syllabus for completing course requirements. The student will then be advised on textbooks and materials required for course completion.

Students enrolled in independent study will work at their own pace, but must complete the course in one semester and 90 days. If the course is part of a Pell Grant award, the course must be completed in the semester of enrollment. If coursework is not completed by the end date, the grade will be an automatic "F."
